The successful candidate will have a passion for teaching students with specialized learning needs, including a belief that every student can learn and make progress. Candidates must demonstrate the ability to create a safe and productive learning environment for students with a variety of academic and behavioral needs.

Other essential knowledge and skills include:

- Plan units and lessons aligned with grade-level standards and demonstrate knowledge of how to differentiate to meet varied academic, behavioral, and social/emotional needs in the classroom.
- Provide instruction in reading, writing, math, and social skills as assigned.
- Co-teaching in ELA, Math, Science, or Social Studies classes as assigned.
- Use appropriate materials, technology, and resources in a manner that promotes students' independence, metacognition, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
- Use a variety of types of assessments to measure students' progress and inform instructional decisions, and academic/behavioral/transition goals.
- Communicate with team members (colleagues and families) in a timely manner regarding students' strengths, needs, and progress
- Maintain the confidentiality of all student information/records and school personnel information.
- Participate in professional meetings and professional development opportunities (in-service, faculty, department, and/or grade level PD).
- Work collaboratively with a team of special education colleagues.
- Use assessment data to develop and monitor IEP goals.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will hold or be able to hold by August 2022 one of the following DPI certifications: Cross Categorical #801 or Emotional Behavioral Disabilities #830.
