In the last 30 days, HACC been viewed **25,600** times and received almost **1700** content interactions.



<u>Grace Lutheran Church</u> donated hats and mittens for Intermediate School students.






<u>First Lutheran Church</u> provided snow pants, sweatpants, hats, gloves, mittens, and socks for Primary and Intermediate School students.
