Dear Fall Festival Vendor,

Welcome to the 40th Annual Fall Festival Art & Craft Show. We're excited to have you join us for this landmark year!

SET-UP DETAILS

Date & Time: Saturday, September 20, 2025. Set-up begins at 6:00 AM.

For safety and logistics, DO NOT start set-up early. You can find your booth number on pages 4 & 5 in alphabetical order by business name. The festival committee has thoughtfully arranged booth placements for festival flow. Please remain in your assigned space. Booth swaps are not allowed. All vendors are required to stay set up for the full event from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Late arrival, early departure, or no-shows may affect future participation.

Helpful Tips:

- Mid-block booths: early arrival (starting at 6:00 AM) helps with access.
- Corner booths: allow others to pass before setting up.
- Unload promptly and move vehicles to vendor parking as soon as possible.


PARKING

Side streets near the festival grounds must remain open for festival attendees. Please use the designated vendor parking areas at Hayward Primary and Intermediate Schools (highlighted on the map in blue on page 3). Avoid parking in nearby private business lots, which enforce towing policies. Vehicles parked in city and festival designated no-parking zones are also subject to towing.

WASTE DISPOSAL

Help us maintain a clean event space:

- Do not leave trash on the street.
- A dumpster is located on Second Street. (marked on map on page 3 with 🔭)



- All garbage must be properly disposed of or removed from the event area. Please break down any boxes before placing them in the designated dumpster.




